Camping and Glamping Terms and Conditions

Please Note: Upon booking you are agreeing to all Adventure 4 You Ltd (company) rules, regulations, restrictions and cancellation policies. It is the responsibility of all those named on the booking (Campers) to ensure that they comply. Any breach may result in the Company requesting they leave the site without refund or compensation.

RULES & REGULATIONS APPLICABLE TO WOODEN BARRELS, SAFARI TENTS, CABIN, CONVERTED BUS.

- Photo identification may be required for all bookings.
- All campers to ensure they do not enter restricted areas on site.
- Smoking or vaping is only permitted outside the entrance at the top gate.
- Only one car is permitted per accommodation to be parked in the designated parking area for the booked accommodation. No vans or other vehicles will be allowed onsite.
- Only campers will be allowed on site. No visitors are permitted.
- Arrival is Friday 3rd July 26 between 9am – 10pm and departure Monday 6th July 26 by 10 am.
- Parking of any vehicles on the site will remain at the discretion of the Company's representatives on site.
- We offer quiet family camping only. The "Company" and the Company's representatives on site, reserve the right to judge acceptable noise levels or behaviour of Campers. The "Company" reserves the right to exclude or eject any Camper from the site if it is considered that the behaviour of such Camper poses a health and safety risk to themselves or another Camper or are likely to cause damage or bring the Campsite into disrepute. In this case, no refunds will be given and the Camper shall indemnify the "Company" against all and any losses, costs, damages, liabilities, claims, demands and expenses suffered or incurred by the company arising out of any exclusion, ejection, or termination under this clause.
- The "Company" reserves the right to refuse any reservation without explanation.
- Campers cannot use any cooking equipment inside or outside the booked accommodation.
- Campers may use portable gas (barbeque gas cylinders not to exceed 15kg), disposable or instant barbeques only in the designated outdoor seating area on the Campsite. All campers must dispose of barbecues and rubbish in the designated area.
- Campers will not be permitted to use any food appliances inside the accommodation.
- Campers should only drink water from the designated drinking water points.
- Campers are not permitted to cut/ remove/ damage any trees or vegetation on the site.
- Campers 16 years and older are classified as adults. Campers 15 years and under will be classified as children. The "Company" reserves the right to require photographic evidence

of proof of age. All children must always be accompanied and supervised by their parent, guardian or carer. In all accommodations only children will sleep on the top bunk.

- Campers park their vehicle (s) on the site at their own risk. The Company will not accept liability for any damage, theft, or loss to the Campers vehicle.
- An extra key deposit of £50 is required for wooden barrels and the family cabin. The deposit will be returned upon return of the keys. Lost keys will forfeit the deposit.
- All Campers must adhere to out of bound areas including all activity areas sign posted.

PROHIBITED ITEMS APPLICABLE TO ALL BOOKINGS

- Sound systems capable of creating excessive noise
- Generators of any type are not permitted.
- 10.1.5 Barbeque Gas cylinders exceeding 15kg.
- Campfires, firewood and fire starters are strictly forbidden.
- Fireworks, pyrotechnics, or smoke cannisters are not permitted.
- Restricted & illegal substances.
- Non-Prescription Drugs.
- Drones or laser pens.
- Offensive weapons.
- Chemicals of any kind.
- Pet animals.
- Items that are deemed dangerous, offensive, or unsuitable for the safe environment of the Campsite.
- The Company reserves the right to stop and search any vehicle and /or vehicle (s) on arrival and to conduct searches in relation to security at any time thereafter as appropriate to ensure the safety of all persons on the Campsite.
- The Company reserves the right to refuse admission to any Camper carrying a Prohibited item and/or to confiscate the prohibited item. No refund will be issued to that camper.
- Unauthorised trading is not permitted within the Campsite or on Company land.
- No live in vehicles/campers vans allowed on site.

BOOKING TERMS, CONDITIONS AND CANCELLATION

- All bookings are made via email directly to the “Company” to info@adventure4you.co.uk
- The booking is personalised to the campers named on the booking and all names and ages will be required at the time of the booking.
- Photographic identification may be taken upon arrival.
- The booking is non-transferable and only those on the original booking can attend.
- The full cost is required at time of booking. There is a 14-day cancellation period during this time a refund will be given minus administrative costs of 25%. After 14 days no refund will be given.
- The name of the lead booker (camper) must be supplied at the time of booking. The lead booker (camper) is responsible for the cost of repairs for any damage caused to the site, equipment and/or property by campers named on their booking.
